



Since 2007 the Houston Health Department (HHD) has worked with various eye care providers and public organizations to provide no cost, quality eye exams and eyewear to children ages 6 -18.

During this clinic, students that fail prescreening vision tests or have been identified by a school representative as having vision problems are transported by their school to the project. Students receive a free comprehensive eye exam and eyewear if needed. Eyewear is delivered to the school within 4-6 weeks from the date students are seen at the clinic.

If you have a student in need of vision correction and with limited or no financial resources to solve the issue, this project may be a solution.
